Managers and Coaches

Northwich Victoria JFC is supporting the FA's Respect programme to ensure football can be enjoyed in a safe and positive environment. Remember children's football is a time for them to develop their technical, physical, tactical and social skills. **WINNING ISN'T EVERYTHING.**

Play your part and observe The FA's Respect campaign in everything you do

1. Coaches must respect the rights, dignity and worth of each player and treat them equally within the context of the sport
2. Coaches must place the wellbeing and safety of each player above all other considerations, including the development of performance
3. Coaches must develop an appropriate working relationship with each player based on mutual trust and respect
4. Coaches must encourage and guide players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance.
5. Coaches must ensure that the activities they direct or advocate are appropriate for the age, maturity, experience and ability of players
6. Coaches should at the outset, clarify with players (and where appropriate parents) exactly what is expected of them
7. Coaches must always promote the positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play) and never condone violation of the Laws of the Game or behaviour contrary to the spirit of the Laws of the Game
8. Coaches must consistently display high standards of behaviour and appearance
9. Coaches must not use or tolerate inappropriate language
10. Coaches must adhere to the NVJFC anti-discrimination and equal opportunities policies
11. Coaches should encourage members of their team to behave in an appropriate manner at all times.

I understand that if I do not follow the code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, county FA, league or the FA

I may be

- Required to meet with the club, league or County Welfare Officer
- Required to meet with the club committee
- Monitored by another club coach
- Required to attend a FA education course
- Suspended by the club from attending matches
- Suspended or fined by the County FA
- Required to leave the club.

- i. Applaud the opposition as well as your own team
- ii. Avoid coaching during the game
